Nearly 3,220 students completed degree requirements from Kansas State University in spring 2019. The graduates are from 101 Kansas counties, 48 states and 48 countries.

The university awarded 2,423 bachelor's degrees, 627 master's degrees, 185 doctorates – 104 of which are Doctor of Veterinary Medicine – and 15 associate degrees. Several students earned multiple degrees.
