

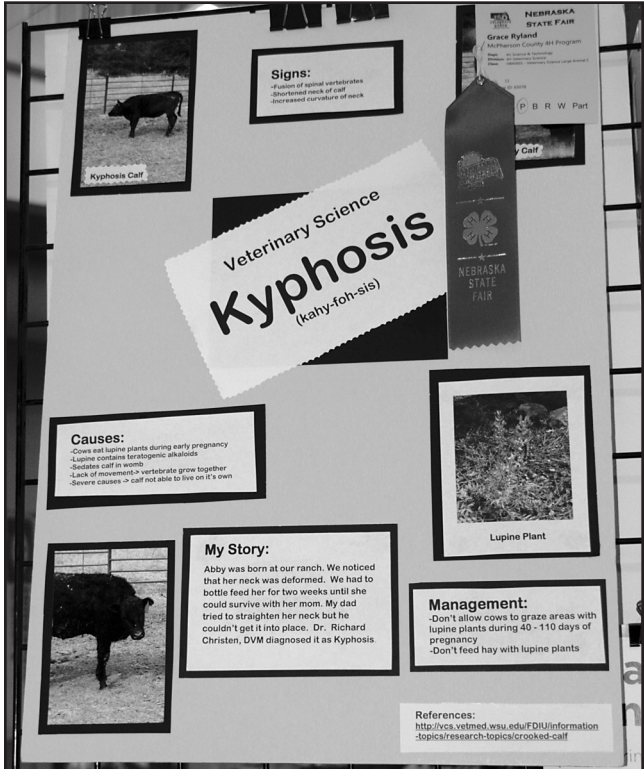

Soper Area Brand Inspector

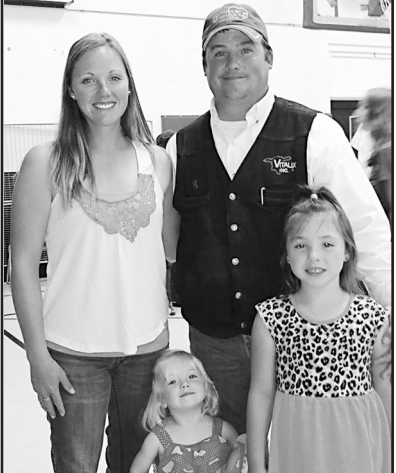
