Licking also received a Red Ribbon (Second Place) for her photo "The Big Ones" as well as Honorable Mentions (yellow Ribbons) for her photos

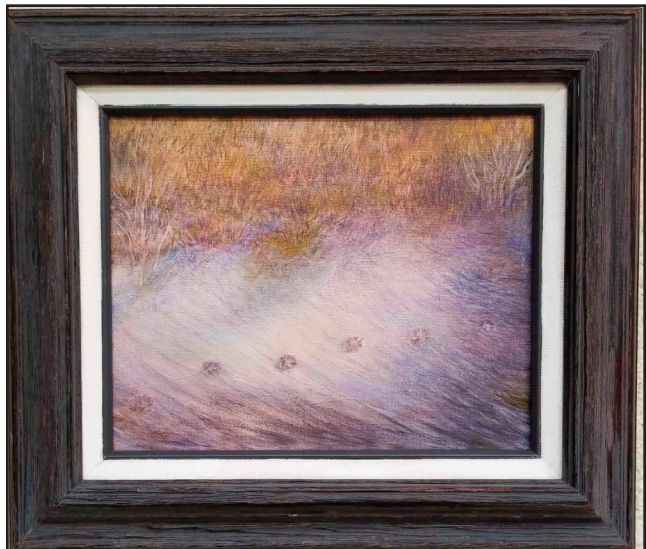
"Yellow Sunflower" and "Round Up."

The show will be up through the month of May in the Kiewit Room at the gallery.

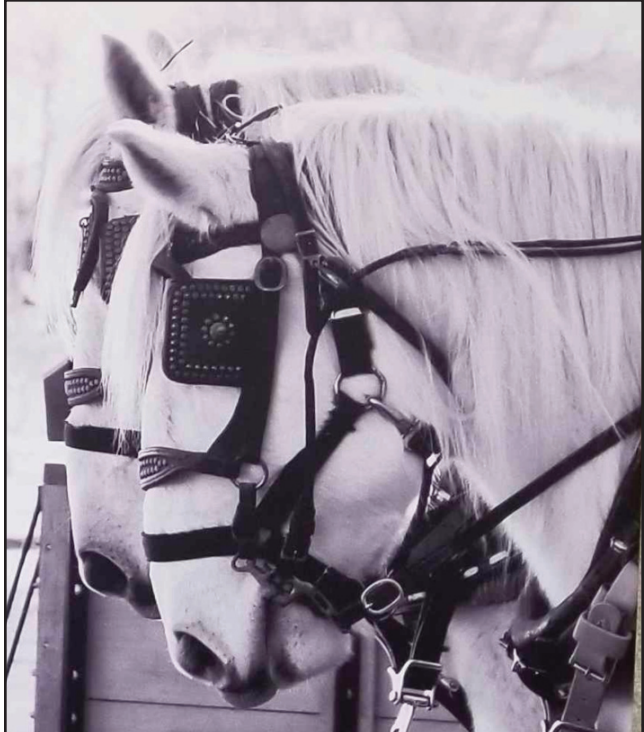

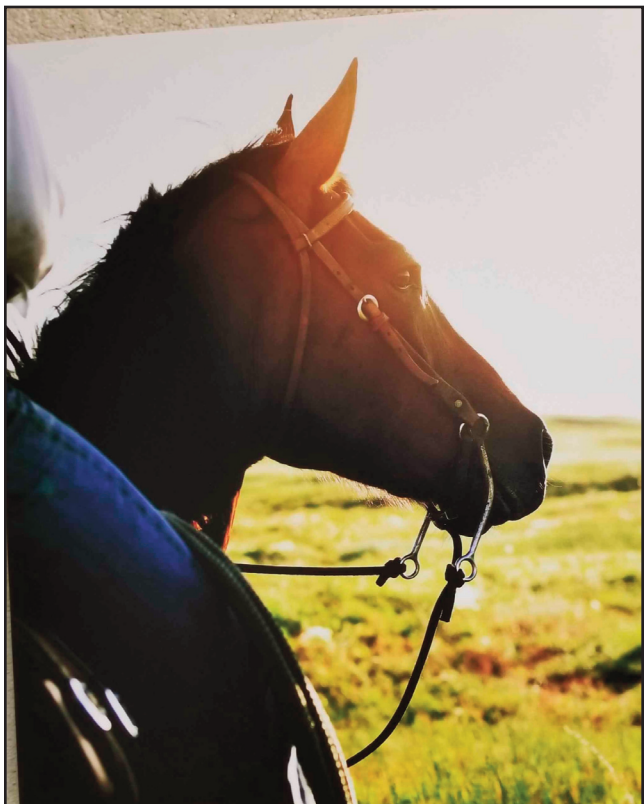
