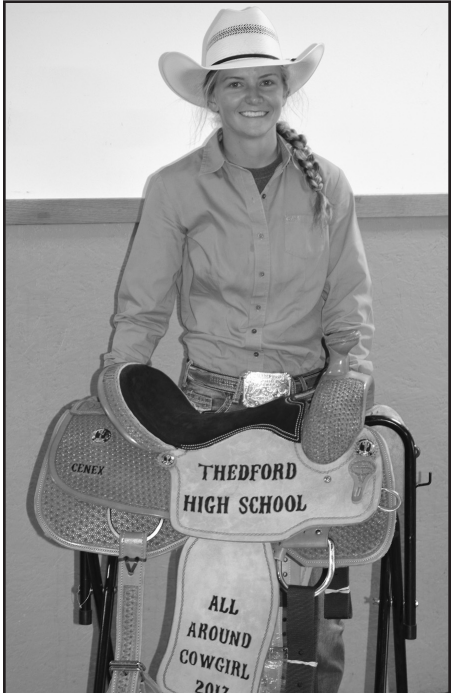
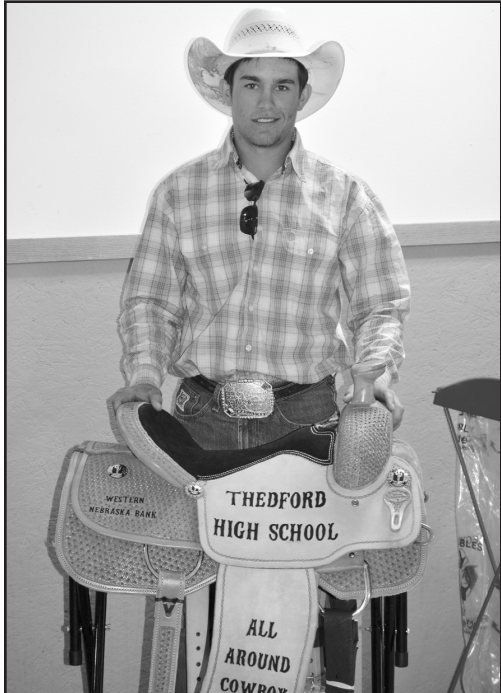


Bradley & Jamison All-Around Winners At THS Rodeo
